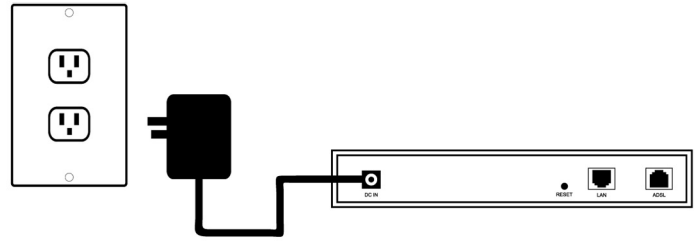
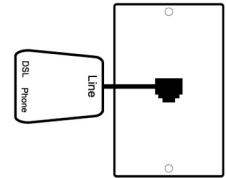


- 1** Plug the power adapter into the wall outlet and connect the cable end to the power port on the modem.

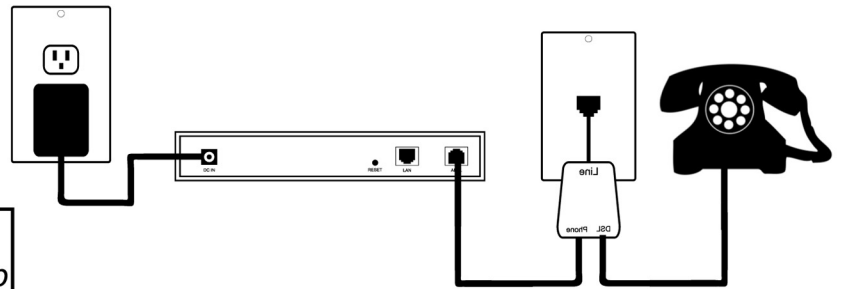


- 2** Connect the cable to splitter to the wall phone outlet.



- 3** Connect your telephone using a phone cable (cable not included) to the phone port on the splitter.

- 4** Connect the phone cable (provided) from the splitter DSL port to the Modem ADSL port.



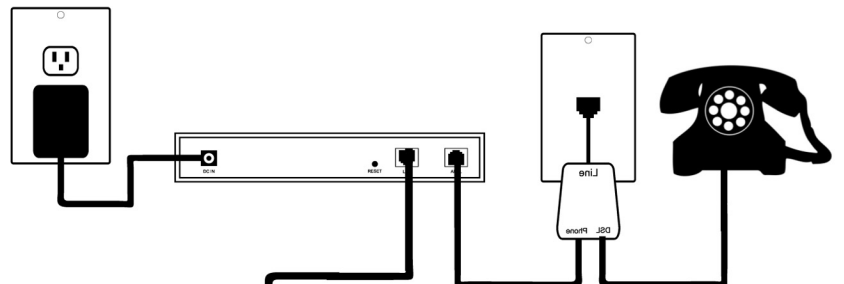
*When the ADSL LED has remained solid green for a full 15 mins, continue with next step*

- 5** Connect data cable ( provided) from the Modem LAN 1 port to PC LAN port.

*Your modem is in bridged mode. While in this mode, the modem accepts only one device and controls all network traffic dedicated to this device.*

- 6** In Microsoft Windows:

**Click Start>Control Panel>Network Connections:**  
*Disable Wireless Network Connection,  
 and other network connections.  
 Enable Local Area Connection  
 No log in needed.*



Open Internet browser to test access.
